



TRANSPORT FACILITIES

1. The institute provides for transport between different starting points at the hostels located in Bhubaneswar city and campus using its own buses on hire. Students residing in Bhubaneswar town and other places have to make their own arrangements to reach the designated pick-up points to avail the transport facility.
2. Students can give their preferred pick-up points to the Manager (Transport Services). The bus route will be determined to the best convenience of all users. It may not be possible to pick up students from remote locations. In planning the route(s), the decision of the manager is final.
3. Any willful damage to bus fittings, interiors, etc., will be penalized by fines levied on the individual or group of students involved.
4. Students who do not want to avail the bus facility and would like to come on their own vehicle must submit an undertaking on Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper stating that "I want my son/daughter, (Name and roll number), to use his/her own vehicle,(details of vehicle), for transport to and from the college. We understand that Indus College of Engineering will not be responsible for any untoward incident arising out of this choice of transportation mode." The undertaking must be signed by the student and the parent/guardian.
5. If a student who has given an undertaking not to avail the college bus facilities is found to be traveling in the bus on any occasion, the college reserves the right to levy fines up to a maximum amount equal to the transport fees for the year.
6. Any student or associate using a two wheeler must use a helmet.(compulsory for all the riders) The college reserves the right to deny parking facilities inside the campus for persons not adhering to the helmet policy.
7. Use of personal vehicles inside the campus during working hours is highly discouraged and should be reserved only for emergency purposes.
