1. The institute has appointed a highly qualified medical consultant to provide free medical consultation to students.
2. The medical assistance rendered by the institute shall be confined to providing first aid and initial humanitarian assistance only, irrespective of whether the medical problem occurs on-campus or of campus.
3. In any medical emergency occurring in the hostel, the concerned student or his/her friend(s) must inform the Hostel Caretaker, Hostel Superintendent and/or the Administrative Officer immediately. At the same time the student or his/her friends(s) must inform the parents /guardians of the patient. This is an absolute must if the student is admitted to any medical/nursing center.
4. The institute will not be held responsible for any subsequent medical problems or emergency situations that might arise due to the negligence of the student.
5. The institute is not responsible for the cost of medicines, hospitalization, specialist fees, etc.
6. Any student found having chronic diseases as declared by Doctors not declared in the admission form may be asked to undergo treatments and rejoin the college after fully cured. All cost to that effect has to be borne by the student/parent/guardians. In the process if he/she loses any semester examinations, his or her promotion to next year will be governed by the BPUT promotion policy.
