



CONSUMPTION OF HARMFUL SUBSTANCES

1. In consonance with international norms for educational institutions and modern healthcare guidelines, Indus has a strict policy on consumption of harmful substances on the campus premises.
2. The entire campus is a NO SMOKING zone. Smoking will not be allowed in any form at any location of the campus.
3. Kindly avoid spitting in the public areas of the college campus.
4. Consumption of any other harmful substances like tobacco powder, gutkha, khaini, etc. is prohibited in the campus.
5. Eating of paan (betel nut preparations) in any form is prohibited in the campus.
6. Consumption of alcohol in any form is prohibited on the campus. Any student or associate found to be under the influence of alcohol inside the campus premises will be liable to the severest punishment including monetary fines, suspension, expulsion, etc.
7. Chewing gum /bubble gum and similar confectionary items are allowed provided that care is taken not to cause pollution in the campus due to improper disposal of the waste matter like wrappers, used chewing gum. etc.
8. These policies are applicable to all students and associates and also to the visitors to our campus. It is the duty of the students and associates to inform any visitor of these policies.
