1. Students are responsible for the safekeeping of their own belongings. The institute shall provide adequate guards but is not responsible for any theft of students' belongings from classroom, buses, etc.
2. If the theft is of a serious magnitude, the institute reserves the right to inform the police about the same.
3. In other issues of law and order like physical assault or battery, the usual procedure is to conduct an investigation by the Disciplinary Committee. However, the institute reserves the right to hand over the case to the police if the case is deemed to be a serious one.
4. The institute does not take the responsibility of ensuring the physical safety and well being of students not staying in the institute Hostels. In case the student is not staying in a INDUS Hostel, the student may approach the police on his /her own but the institute will not be involved.
5. In law and order issues which arise from incidents happening outside the campus, Indus hostels, and buses of Indus, the institute will not get involved officially. However, we may provide help on humanitarian grounds where possible.
6. All disputes concerning Indus College of Engineering are subject to Bhubaneswar jurisdiction.
