



## DRESS CODE FOR THE CAMPUS

**This rule is applicable to all ASSOCIATES of the College:**

1. All male students and associates are expected to come to College dressed in formal clothes.
  - Trousers with normal pockets and normal length are acceptable.
  - Bermudas, cargoes, shorts, etc. are NOT acceptable.
  - Plain T-shirts with collars and not having any printed/embroidered patterns are acceptable. They must be tucked into the trousers/pants.
  - Shirts having either full sleeves or half sleeves with normal pockets and collar are acceptable.
  - Multicolor party shirts and party shirts made of shiny materials are NOT acceptable.
  - Shirts must be tucked into the pants with a decent belt.
  - Full shoes (either leather or sports) with socks are acceptable.
  - Sandals and *chappals* are NOT acceptable.
  - Simple jeans are acceptable. Jeans having faded color patterns, multicolor jeans, cutoffs, jeans having embroidery patterns, jeans with painted figures, etc. are NOT acceptable.
2. All female students and associates are expected to come to college dressed in formal cloths:
  - Sarees and blouses or Salwar/Kameez or Skirts and blouses (skirts not above knee length) are acceptable.
  - Blouse sleeves above elbow length are not recommended.
  - Clothes having shiny decorations like metal plates, metal flowers, sequins, etc. are NOT acceptable.
  - Shoes with normal heels are acceptable.
  - Spiked shoes/ extra high heels are NOT acceptable
  - Bangles, and paayal, etc., which distract attention by creating noises are NOT acceptable.
3. All male students and associates are expected to keep the head hair length up to maximum length of two inches. Pony tails etc. are NOT acceptable.
4. All students and associates are expected to maintain their normal hair color.
5. All male students and associates are expected to come to college properly shaved. If somebody wants to keep a beard, the beard should be properly trimmed, not to be left unkempt.
6. All unusual and fancy/party dresses are not allowed inside the campus.
  - Jeans with more than two front and back pockets are NOT acceptable.
  - Short shirts above hip length are NOT acceptable.
  - Belts having large and flashy buckles are NOT acceptable.

## **DRESS CODE FOR THE CAMPUS**

- Pockets of trousers and shirts having extra fittings like chains etc. are NOT acceptable.
  - Trouser and shirts having different monograms screen printed or stitched are NOT acceptable.
  - Shirts/kameezs stitched with see-thru fabrics are NOT acceptable.
  - Round neck or color neck "T" shirts are NOT allowed.
  - Head bands and wrist bands of any type is not allowed.
  - Wearing chains with different type of monograms exposed is not allowed.
  - All dress materials should be of fabric and no animal skin products are allowed.
7. Punishment for violation of this code will be decided by the Director (Admin) or any members of the disciplinary committee on a case by case basis. This may include fines, suspension, loss of salary, etc.
